SHRINKING DISC

- Any piece of equipment can be dangerous if not operated properly. YOU are responsible for the safe operation of this equipment. The operator must carefully read and follow any warnings, safety signs and instructions provided with or located on the equipment. Do not remove, defeat, deface or render inoperable any of the safety devices or warnings on your equipment. If any safety devices or warnings have been removed, defeated, defaced or rendered inoperable, **DO NOT USE THIS EQUIPMENT!!!**
- **WARNING!** This product contains or produces one or more chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.
- Do not tape down or otherwise by-pass any safety devices! Always operate this equipment from the designated operators position.
- Never operate power equipment of any kind if you are tired or if you are under the influence of alcohol, drugs, medication or any substance that could affect your ability or judgment. Be alert! If you get tired while operating this equipment, take a break. Tiredness may result in loss of control.
- **Use extreme caution:** The shrinking disc is very sharp! Keep your hands, feet and all other body parts clear of the disc always.
- Always wear eye, dust, and hearing protection.
- **Warning** disc gets very hot during use. Use care when changing disc.
- Never carry this tool by the power cord and never use the cord to unplug the tool.

IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES TO FOLLOW

1. Do not use power tools in damp or wet locations. Do not expose power tools to rain. Failure to follow these instructions increases the risk of electrocution.
2. Avoid gaseous areas. Do not operate electric tools in explosive atmospheres in the presence of flammable liquids or gases. This motor creates sparks, which could ignite fumes.
3. Do not wear loose clothing or jewelry. Wear safety glasses, ear protection, and dust mask. Keep hands away from rotation area and disc.
4. Always inspect disc for damage. Keep cords away from cutting area when operating.
5. Avoid accidental starting. Be sure the switch is in the "OFF" position before plugging into outlet. Don't carry plugged in tool with finger on switch.
6. Do not use damaged disc. Keep guards in place and in working order.
7. Do not run the disc while carrying it at your side.
8. Secure item to be worked before working; never hold pieces in your hand or across legs.
9. Keep second hand on auxiliary handle, not near the disc.
10. KICKBACK CAN OCCUR AT ANY TIME! DO NOT USE DAMAGED DISC AND SUPPORT WORK PROPERLY.

If the person receiving this handout will not be the user of the equipment, forward these instructions to the operator. If there is any doubt as to the operation or safety of the equipment, DO NOT USE!
